## MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TOM MYERS



tough

Last year CSA received federal stimulus funds to assist those impacted by the economic downturn. The dollars came from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) which is part of the Department of Housing and Urban Development. They totaled more than \$200,000 for CSA alone, which gives you an idea of the severity of the situation just in our own community.

No matter on which side of the political fence you sit, there are two facts which are undeniable about this government funding.

First, that government money has helped hundreds of families in Northern Santa Clara County ride out the worst economic times since the great depression. People who would have swelled the welfare rolls or would have been forced to live in their cars or would have gone without food to pay rent were assisted with this funding. These people were families with children, individuals, senior citizens and homeless individuals. People who thought that they never would need assistance were getting help from the local charity.

Second, government funding is not sustainable. These funds are not the solution. At best, they provide only a safety-net to keep a family from an even worse crisis. At worst, if the economy doesn't turn around, they only delay the inevitable.

Government funding poses a tough challenge to CSA. Our staff and volunteers have done a great job of meeting the ever increasing numbers of people coming through our doors. Look at the statistics and read the stories on the next few pages.

The fact is low-income workers and homeless individuals are the first affected by a bad economy and the last to feel any recovery when the economy improves. We can only expect to see a leveling of demand at best in the near future.

But we've already been notified that one source of stimulus funds is drying up. The tough decision is how do we maintain any meaningful level of assistance to those who need it when government funds go away?

CSA will embark on a strategic planning process again this year. Our current 3-year plan – a living document and roadmap for us - will expire in June 2011. Programs and service continuity will be high on the agenda as we plan for the next few years.

CSA will navigate these rough waters just as all of you have. It will take continued judicious use of reserves, keen fiscal oversight by our board of directors, skillful management and administration of services by staff, heartfelt dedication of volunteers and just plain hard work by those caught in this economic vise.

As we report on this past year and appeal to you for the future, I want to personally thank you for your investment in CSA and in the people we serve.

### Mission Statement

---

We are the community's safety net, providing critical support services that preserve and promote stability, self-reliance and dignity.

Poverty and need is just one paycheck or financial emergency away for many. Even though Mountain View, Los Altos and Los Altos Hills are among the wealthiest communities in the country, poverty does exist here among us, sometimes even in our neighborhood.

**\$65,598** - The “self-sufficiency standard” – how much income is needed by a family of four to adequately meet their basic needs without any subsidies in Santa Clara County.

**\$16,284** - The average income for a family of four coming to CSA for emergency assistance.

As jobs are cut or hours reduced more and more people are forced to make some very hard decisions every payday (if there is a payday). Buy food? Pay rent? Pay utilities? Buy prescriptions? Seek medical help?

Every decision is a major financial decision.

- Low-income workers cannot adequately provide the basic necessities for themselves or their children, i.e., housing, food, and school supplies.
- Without a living wage, affordable housing and health care coverage, low-income workers can never get a foothold on the ladder toward self-sufficiency.
- Low-income individuals and families are at risk of becoming a permanent underclass with little hope of stability let alone upward mobility.

#### RENT & UTILITY ASSISTANCE

**81%** of our clients who received rent or utility assistance were able to remain in their homes for at least one year after receiving assistance.

## EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE SAFETY-NET SERVICES

- Financial Assistance is available for rent, utilities, housing, dental care and eye exams.
- Back-to-School assistance offers backpacks, school supplies and shoe vouchers for school-age children. Fee waiver vouchers are also available for Mountain View Recreation Department.
- Holiday Sharing engages the entire community in food, clothing and toy drives and as volunteers to make the Holiday time brighter for low-income families with children and for seniors.
- Our Food & Nutrition Center provides essential and basic food items 5x/week. Special Holiday food bags are provided in both November and December

## food insecurity

**191** - The average number of people who shop each day at our Food and Nutrition Center.

**47,000** - The number of people who shopped last year.

**600,000** - The number of pounds for food donated.

**72%** - The percentage of distributed food which can be considered healthy.

People cannot fully maximize their potential, i.e. learn in school or function well on the job, if they are hungry or preoccupied with how they will secure enough food for themselves and their families.

Infants and children who do not receive adequate nutrition do not develop physically and mentally on par with their peers

## NUTRITION EDUCATION

**94%** of our Food & Nutrition Center survey respondents reported that they are making better food choices as a result of our health education days.

### The Aguilar family

**Family:** 2 adults and 3 children

**Income:** \$28,800

**Housing:** 2 bedroom apartment: \$1,495/month rent.

Client is not working. Her husband works as a construction worker. The family receives food from our Food & Nutrition Center. The two school-age children were assisted with backpacks, school supplies and shoe vouchers. They were also signed up to receive a waiver from the Recreation Department in Mountain View. Without health insurance the client was also referred to health and dental clinics.

It's a myth that all homeless people are drug users, mentally ill, or just plain lazy. Housing requires the largest proportion of a wage earner's income and it's the first expense to take a hit when an economic downturn or crisis occurs.

As people are laid off or have their hours cut they face the prospect of eviction, and if evicted many of the "homeless" people live in cars or move in with friends (couch surf) until they can get back on their feet.

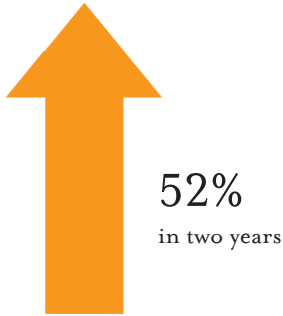
**Victor C.**

**Family:** Divorced  
**Income:** \$28,800  
**Housing:** Lives in a camper

Victor was sleeping on the streets, had no job, and no benefits when he came to CSA. His case manager assisted him with obtaining public benefits, transportation, food, and clothing. He received help finding employment and now has a full-time job with full benefits. Victor has learned to manage his budget and is saving to rent a place of his own.

**Nancy B.**

**Family:** Single, 2 kids  
**Income:** \$15,480  
**Housing:** Temporarily staying with a friend

Nancy was laid off and while waiting for unemployment benefits to start, she was evicted from her apartment for not paying the rent. CSA provided financial assistance that helped Nancy and her family secure stable housing in Mountain View. The family is also assisted with food from the Food & Nutrition Center.

HOUSING ASSISTANCE

57% of those who came to CSA for assistance in locating affordable housing were able to be housed.

Affordable housing is a major challenge for many people in Silicon Valley with service sector jobs.

## senior services



The number of seniors over 65 in Silicon Valley will double by 2025, overwhelming the capacity of existing retirement communities, nursing homes and assisted living facilities.

The average cost of a MediCal nursing home placement is \$43K annually and rising.

Case management programs which include comprehensive geriatric assessments that address the medical, social, physical and mental challenges that seniors face with aging keeps them living independently and on their own, with improved health status and quality of life.

**97%** of the seniors who received case management services were able to live and remain independent in their own homes.

**99%** of the hospital discharged seniors who received chronic disease management education as part of an intensive case management regimen did not have to be readmitted to the hospital for the same chronic condition within 30 days post discharge.

**92%** of the hospital discharged seniors who received chronic disease management education and intensive case management were not readmitted to the hospital for the same chronic condition for at least one year.

## case management

### MEDICARE READMISSION RATE

**18%** of Medicare patients admitted to the hospital nationally are readmitted within 30 days of discharge, adding billions to health care costs.

The number of seniors provided case management services has risen to 308.

Many seniors live alone, without family support and company near by. They are less apt to cook for themselves, usually have less of an appetite, more prone to eat high sodium single serving prepared food and prefer to “nosh” versus eating a well-balanced meal.

Many seniors also have limited opportunities for social interaction. Our Senior Nutrition Program at the Mountain View Senior Center ensures they have access to a well-balanced meal that meets all the nutritional requirements for persons age 60 and older as well as social activities that reduce the isolation experienced by many of our seniors.

**85%** of the respondents to our annual client survey reported that they are able to live independently as a result of attending the Senior Nutrition Program.

**98%** of survey respondents reported that their physical health and spirits were maintained by the socialization offered through the Senior Nutrition Program

**94%** of survey respondents reported that they are healthier as a result of attending the Senior Nutrition Program.

# MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT RICHARD MAGNUSON



As you all know, CSA is our community's safety net for those less fortunate citizens who are going through times of need. The agency fulfills its mission through the efforts of its staff with the help of many different people who devote their time volunteering for CSA. Our volunteers are involved with activities as varied as picking up surplus food from supermarkets for the Food & Nutrition Center, shelving bread, stuffing envelopes, helping with the Holiday Sharing Program in December, and countless other activities.

One group of volunteers that works mostly in the background is the CSA board of directors: a group of anywhere from 16-20 community members. As President of the Board this year I can assure you they are committed and talented individuals who generously give their time to the agency. They serve a 3 year term and are eligible for only 2 terms to ensure that new blood and new thinking is always available.

These individuals bring a diversity of backgrounds, skills and experiences which combine to help the board effectively monitor both the operating activities of CSA as well as help with longer-term strategic issues. The board members come from the three communities served by CSA, Mountain View, Los Altos and Los Altos Hills, bringing key insights and connections to the agency from their different communities.

One of the major activities of the CSA board is assisting staff with fundraising. CSA relies on funding from individuals, families, foundations, corporations and government agencies. Our year-end appeal is part of our Annual Report to you at this time of the year. Our fundraising events – the Spring Gala and Hometown Heroes – are two other ways to engage the community in support.

With government funding being cut we rely more and more on the generosity of people like you. None of us is unaffected by the current economic downturn; some of us, though, are truly pushed to their limits and rely on CSA to keep them on their feet. We need your support and generosity again this year.

The good news is that the Sobrato Family Foundation has generously given CSA a challenge match under which the Foundation will match \$2 for every \$1 dollar CSA raises (up to \$44,000). Eligible contributions are:

- Donations from **first-time donors**.
- Donations from **lapsed donors** who have not given to CSA in the past 12 months.
- **Increased giving by current donors**.

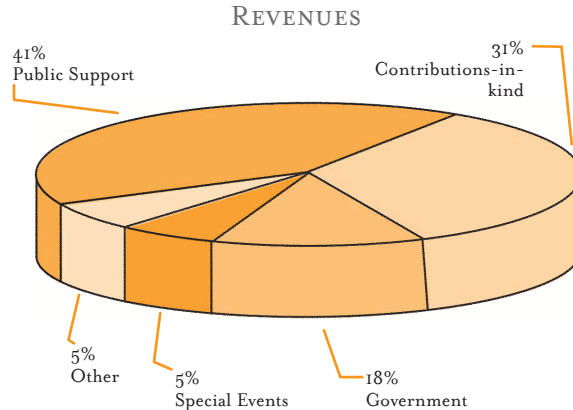

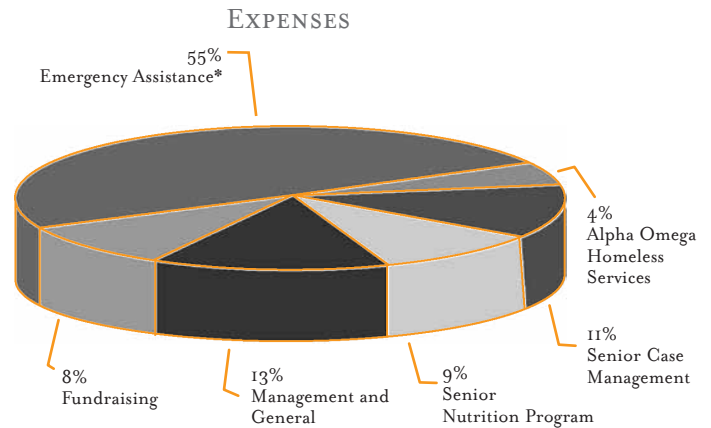
